- Meats are restaurant quality; many are vacuum sealed or IQF (individually quick frozen).
- Orders are prepaid by cash or money orders or U.S. Food Stamp Voucher system.

Bethel Park Free Methodist Church has partnered with Angel Food Ministries, a non-profit non-denominational organization dedicated to providing grocery relief to communities throughout the U.S. God has blessed this outreach effort, providing a quality, low cost grocery supplement to families across 32 states. Bethel Park Church is excited about this outreach to our members and to all families throughout Flint Township and the surrounding areas. This ministry meets the needs of individuals and families in a very tangible way.



HOW IT WORKS

Food sales and distribution are handled by Bethel Park Church. Orders and payments are collected during the first part of each month. Volunteers from the church pick up the food and prepare for Distribution Day. Customers then come to the church on Distribution Day to get their food, bringing their own box(es) or baskets to be filled and their receipt. All food not picked up on Distribution Day by the designated time will be donated to local families.

BLESSINGS BY THE BOX

Angel Food's groceries are sold in a quantity that can fit into a medium-sized box at \$30 per unit. Each month's menu is different and consists of both fresh and frozen items with an average retail value of approximately \$50. Comparison shopping has been done across the country in various communities using a wide range of retail grocery stores and has resulted in the same food items costing from between \$42 and \$78.

Generally, one unit of food assists in feeding a family of four for about one week or a single senior citizen for almost a month. The food is all the same high quality one would purchase at a grocery store. There are no second-hand items, no damaged or out-dated goods, no dented cans without labels, no day-old breads and no products that is almost too ripe.

Also, offered are specialty boxes such as steaks, chicken and pork. Many participants in this bonus program appreciate the expanded choices. Additionally, there is no limit to the number of units or bonus foods and individual can purchase, and there are no applications to complete or qualifications to which participants must adhere. Angel Food Ministries, like most all other retail grocer store, also participates in the U.S. Food Stamp Voucher System.
