There are 66 books in the Bible. The challenge this year is to memorize 1 verse from each book. Since there are only 52 weeks and 66 books some week will have 2 verses which are short. You may use these verses or pick ones of your own. Are you up to the challenge?

Jan. 7th Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth"
Exodus 6:6 "I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts
Of judgment"

Jan. 14th Leviticus 20:7 "'Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the Lord
your God"
Numbers 14:18 "The Lord is slow to anger, abounding in love and forgiving
sin and rebellion."

Jan. 21st Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, O Israel, what does the LORD your God ask
of you but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the
LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul,

Jan. 28th Joshua 1:8 Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate
on it day and night,
Judges 21:25 In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as he saw fit.

Feb. 4th Ruth 1:16 But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from
you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my
people and your God my God.

Feb. 11th I Samuel 15:22 To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the
fat of rams.
II Samuel 22:22 For I have kept the ways of the Lord; I have not done evil
by turning from my God.

Feb. 18th 1 Kings 3:9 So give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and
to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of
yours?

Feb. 25th 2 Kings 6:16 16 "Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. "Those who are with
us are more than those who are with them."

March 4th 1 Chronicles 29:11 11 Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power
and the glory and the majesty and the splendor,
for everything in heaven and earth is yours.
Yours, O LORD, is the kingdom;
you are exalted as head over all

March 11th 2 Chronicles 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.

March 18th Ezra 7:10 10 For Ezra had devoted himself to the study and observance of the Law of the LORD, and to teaching its decrees and laws in Israel

March 25th Nehemiah 4:9 But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat.

Esther 4:14 14 For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. And who knows but that you have come to royal position for such a time as this?"

April 1st Job 19:25 25 I know that my Redeemer [a] lives, and that in the end he will stand upon the earth.

Psalm 51:10 10 Create in me a pure heart, O God,
and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

April 8th Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge,
but fools [a] despise wisdom and discipline.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

April 15th Song of Solomon 8:7 7 Many waters cannot quench love; neither can the floods drown it.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions,
he was crushed for our iniquities;

April 22nd Jeremiah 31:33 "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts I will be their God, and they will be my people".

Lamentations 3:24 I say to myself, "The LORD is my portion;
therefore I will wait for him."

April 29th Ezekiel 36:27 And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws.

Daniel 2:22 He reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with him.

May 6th Hosea 14:5 I will be like the dew to Israel; he will blossom like a lily. Like a cedar of Lebanon he will send down his roots;

May 13th Joel 2:28 And afterward,
I will pour out my Spirit on all people.
Your sons and daughters will prophesy,
your old men will dream dreams,
your young men will see visions.

May 20th Amos 9:15 I will plant Israel in their own land,
never again to be uprooted
from the land I have given them,"
says the LORD your God.

May 27th Obadiah 1:4
Though you soar like the eagle
and make your nest among the stars,
from there I will bring you down,"
declares the LORD.

June 3rd Jonah 4:2 He prayed to the LORD, "O LORD, is this not what I said when I
was still at home? That is why I was so quick to flee to Tarshish. I knew that you are a
gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who
relents from sending calamity.

June 10th Micah 6:8 He has showed you, O man, what is good.
And what does the LORD require of you?
To act justly and to love mercy
and to walk humbly with your God.

Jun 17th Nahum 1:7 The LORD is good,
a refuge in times of trouble.
He cares for those who trust in him,

June 24th Habakkuk 2:4 See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright—but the
righteous will live by his faith

July 1st Zephaniah 2:3 Seek righteousness, seek humility, perhaps you will be
sheltered on the day of the Lord's anger.

July 8th Haggai 2:5 'This is what I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt.
And my Spirit remains among you. Do not fear.'

July 15th Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion!
Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem!
See, your king [a] comes to you,
righteous and having salvation,
gentle and riding on a donkey,

on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

July 22nd Malachi 4:2 But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall.

July 29th Matthew 28:19, 20 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in[a] the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

August 5th Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

August 12th Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."

August 19th John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son,[a] that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

August 26th Acts 19:20 In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power.

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we[a]have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

September 2nd 1 Corinthians 13:13 And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

September 9th 2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness,"[a]made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

September 16th Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

September 23rd Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—

September 30th Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

October 7th Colossians 3:23 Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men,

October 14th I Thessalonians 5:24 The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.

October 21st II Thessalonians 2:15 So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the teachings[a] we passed on to you, whether by word of mouth or by letter.

October 28th I Timothy 6:11 pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.

II Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.

November 4th Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men.

November 11th Philemon 15, 16 Perhaps the reason he was separated from you for a little while was that you might have him back for good—no longer as a slave, but better than a slave, as a dear brother.

November 18th Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.

November 25th James 1:12 Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

December 2nd I Peter 2:24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

II Peter 2:9 If this is so, then the Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials and to hold the unrighteous for the day of judgment, while continuing their punishment.

December 9th I John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

December 16th II John 1:6 And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love.

III John 1:11 Dear friend, do not imitate what is evil but what is good.

December 23rd Jude 1:24 To him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy—

December 30th Revelation 3:20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.
